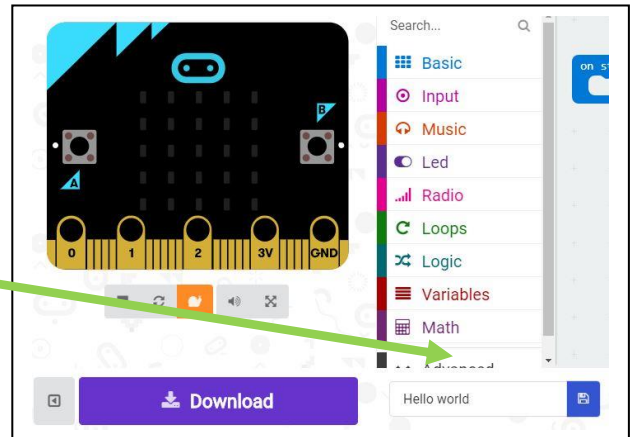


# Coding Apprenticeship

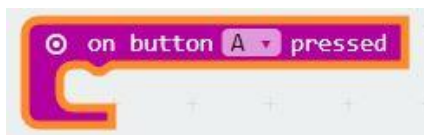
In order to work on the Land Rover BAR project you need to complete your coding apprenticeship. Follow the instructions below carefully. You need to get the micro:bit to scroll the words 'Hello World' when you press Button A.

1. Click on 'New project'.
2. Rename your code 'Hello World' by typing 'Hello World' in the box shown

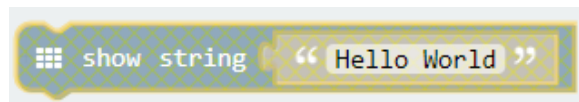


3. You could start the programme as soon as the BBC micro:bit is plugged in to a power source but we are going to start it when Button A is pressed. To do this we need to add an **input** to our code so click on **input**.

4. Choose



5. Then go to **Basic** and choose show string. You can then type in the words you want to show when Button A is pressed. You need to type in 'Hello World'.



6. Put the two pieces of code together and watch the simulator.

7. Download it to your BBC micro:bit by pressing



8. Press Button 'A' on your BBC micro:bit and watch what happens.
